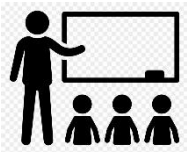
Remote Learning at StGBS



If a **child or family** are sent home to isolate, physical packs of work will be sent home in an envelope from the class teacher to be completed on the sheets. All children will be expected to use their home access to digital programmes called Bug Club and Education City.

In FSU and KS1 the children will also be able to access Phonics Play from home.

Children in KS2 also have home access to Times Table Rock Star as well as the weekly homework set on Google Classroom.



If a **whole class** is sent home during term time:-

FSU - each child will be sent home with an exercise book to keep a diary in (recording in words and pictures) and a physical pack of work which will be sent home in an envelope from the class teacher to be completed on the sheets. The children will also have access to Bug Club, Phonics Play and Education City – all sites can be accessed from tablets, laptops, computers and phones.

From November parents will have access to their child's Learning Journal online which they will be able to upload photos and comments about their child's home learning.

In both instances we will contact families via a phone call once a fortnight to check in and give support where needed.

KS1- each child will receive a daily message via email (before 9am) which will explain their child's learning for the day. Each child will be sent home with an exercise book to record home learning. The children will also have access to Bug Club, Phonics Play and Education City – all sites can be accessed from tablets, laptops, computers and phones.

We will also contact families via a phone call once a fortnight to check in and give support where needed.

KS2 - children will access work via Google Classroom. Children have been shown how to access this and a user guide will be available on the school website. Resources will be posted in the Lockdown Classrooms for each year group and the children will do work in a red book which will be sent home with them. Class teachers will be online from 9-10am and 1-2pm Monday – Friday to communicate with the children as to which resources to use and what to do. The children will be expected to log in twice a day as a form of registration and so their teacher can communicate with them about work.
